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Public Participation Report, ADP FY 2026/2027

1.0 Overview of Public Participation

The County Government of Busia, through the Department of County Treasury and Economic Planning – Directorate of Economic Planning, convened public participation forums for the Annual Development Plan (ADP) for FY 2026/2027 on 19th August 2025 across all eight sub-counties, as per the schedule in the attached Newspaper Public Participation Advertisement. The exercise attracted a total of 957 participants, of whom 40% were female and 60% male. Youth (below 35 years) accounted for 20% of attendees, while Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) comprised 3% of the participants. In line with inclusivity principles, minority groups, CBOs, FBOs and Civil Society Organizations were also represented. The Busia County Budget and Economic Forum (CBEF) actively participated in the exercise, alongside organizations such as Community Empowerment and Development Centre (CEDC), UNICEF, and ICPAK, who submitted both oral and written memoranda. The forums were structured around ward-level break-out sessions, where participants deliberated on development priorities and shared proposals. These views were subsequently synthesized and aligned with respective departmental mandates. The sessions achieved their primary objectives:

- ❖ To involve citizens in articulating their development aspirations.
- ❖ To inform the public on county development priorities and resource allocation.
- ❖ To strengthen accountability by capturing community feedback in line with Section 117(5) of the PFM Act, 2012.

- **Agriculture:** Mechanization, livestock support, and value addition interventions respond directly to farmers' aspirations for improved productivity and market access.
- **Health:** Expanded health infrastructure, medical staffing, and emergency services address citizen demands for better healthcare delivery.
- **Infrastructure (Roads & Water):** Investments in feeder roads, bridges, boreholes, and piped water systems align with public calls for enhanced accessibility and service equity.
- **Education:** Additional classrooms, bursaries, and ECDE feeding programmes ensure inclusive education opportunities for learners.
- **Governance:** Community oversight and ward committees strengthen participatory governance and accountability.

This alignment underscores the County's commitment to inclusive planning, participatory budgeting, and responsive service delivery, thereby reinforcing public confidence in devolution and local development.


THE KWALE COUNTY ANNUAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FINANCIAL YEAR 2026/2027
